Overall goals of Lions International – Financial assistance with sight, hearing, and diabetes programs

Specific activities of the Albion Lions Club as of 2025

- 1) Host a complete Thanksgiving dinner for all Albion residents 70 years old and those living alone
- 2) Organize and finance a Christmas Giving Tree project that provides 15 – 25 needy families and 50 – 70 children with gifts of clothing, boots, toys, and other necessary essentials
- 3) Assist with Field Day activities
- 4) Maintain flags along Albion Main Street
- 5) Fun Run annually
- 6) Purchase glasses for those in need of financial assistance
- 7) Financially support a host of programs such as:
 - a) Police Athletic League (PAL)
 - b) Scholarship for an Albion student graduating from LHS
 - c) Loaves & Fishes Food Pantry

- 1) Member ideas presented throughout the year
- 2) Tent rentals

Monthly Meeting and Member Cost

- 1) Lions Club meets once a month on the second Thursday from March through December. The monthly meeting is a combination of potluck dinners, a meal prepared by members, or hors d'oeuvres
- 2) Initiation fee is paid for by the club
- 3) Annual dues are: \$55.00 for individuals or \$85.00 for 2 family members
- 4) Spouses or friends are always welcome even if they are not a paying member
